What is the Project about?

The goal of this project is the development of a cloud architecture for the creation and the distribution of improved multimedia material taken from many different sources (e.g., the phone cameras of the people following an event). The planned cloud architecture is scalable and flexible, the nodes belonging to the cloud can range from small processing unit (e.g., tablet wirelessly connected) to very large and powerful nodes. The scalability of the architecture relies on a new concept of distributed and amorphous computation, called “computational magma.” The protocols behind the architecture will be open, allowing for easy wide-spreading and deploying of the proposed architecture.
