## Introducing the next Idealist project – Idealist2018

The Idealist2014 project which ran for more than three years since October 2011 came to an end in December 2014. The Idealist2014 partners are glad to have successfully completed yet another ICT National Contact Point (NCP) Support Action project that was funded under FP7.

Ideal-ist network partners are pleased to announce the official commencement of the new Ideal-ist project – **Idealist2018 in January 2015**, which is funded under the Horizon2020 EC programme.

This project is open to all ICT NCPs regardless of their individual status within the European Union, with a particular focus on the needs of new ICT NCPs and ICT-related topic contacts for Third Countries. The Project coordinator is MATIMOP-ISERD, from Israel.

CHOICE Final Event: Lisbon, October 19/20–22, 2015 - **Providing continuous progress in strengthening China collaboration on ICT RDI with Europe**

From October 19th to October 22<sup>nd</sup>, the CHOICE project will host its final event on “**Providing continuous progress in strengthening China collaboration on ICT RDI with Europe**”, which will take place in Lisbon, Portugal.

The CHOICE final event will be dual and will be composed of (i) a **main conference** and (ii) a **booth at ICT 2015**, the European Commission flagship event.

On **October 19<sup>th</sup>**, the **main conference** will provide all attendees with an opportunity to discuss and exchange on best practices related to EU-China cooperation in the field of ICT RDI. The event, to be held at the AIP-CCI Headquarters the day prior to the opening of ICT 2015 will (i) provide access to the latest information on future opportunities for EU-China collaboration in ICT RDI within the framework of Horizon 2020, (ii) showcase success cases and (iii) discuss priority topics in the field. Participants will also have the opportunity to further interact with the speakers and network with other attendees to initiate joint projects.

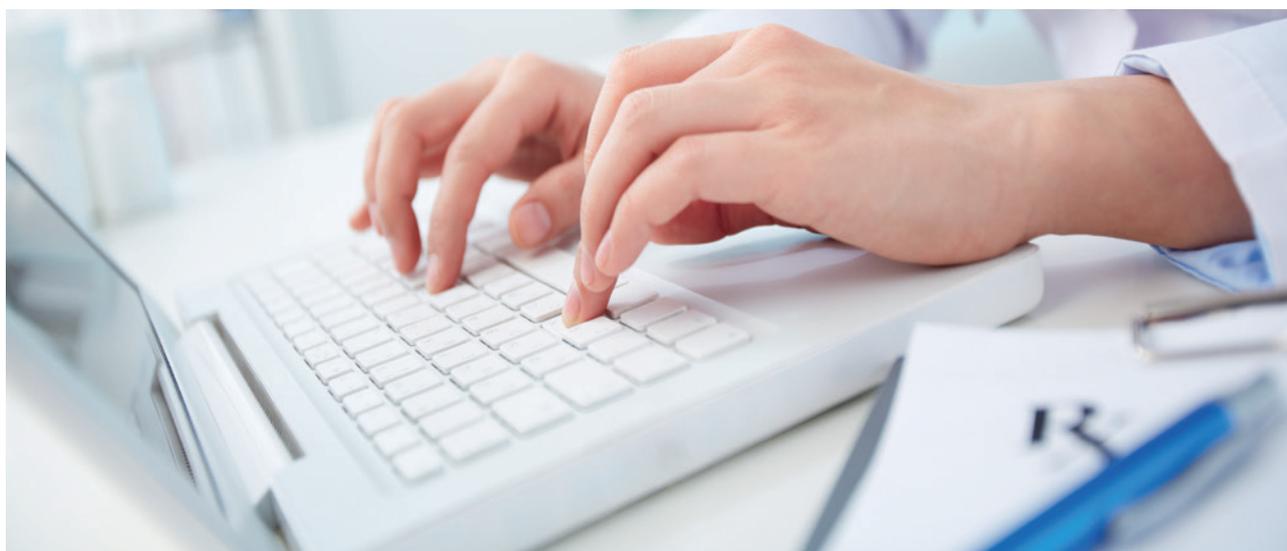
