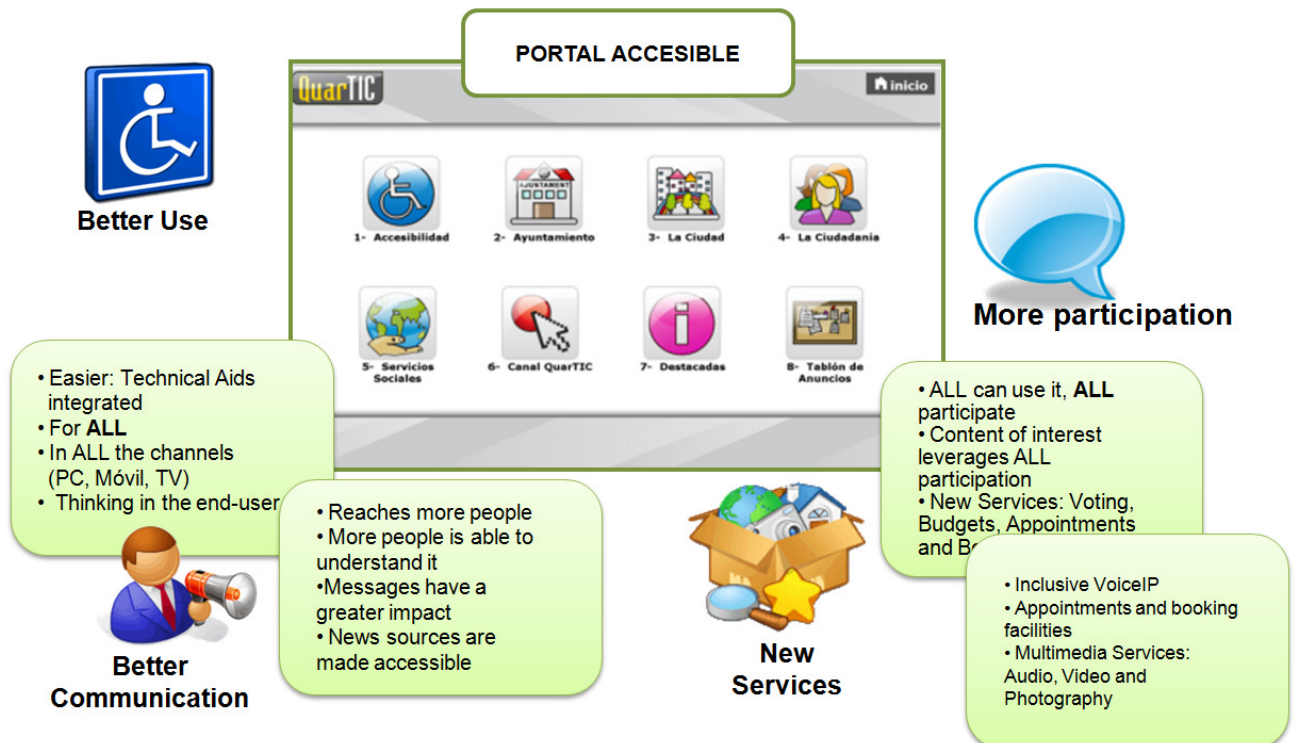

## About Ideal-ist

---

Ideal-ist is the first and unique quality labelled international ICT partner search network with 13 years experience. The network of Ideal-ist consists of 63 national contact points (NCP) in the area of Information and Communications Technologies. The Consortium members are from EU and Non-EU Countries, including Associated States, Eastern European Partner Countries (EEPC) and Mediterranean Partner Countries (MPC) and Emerging countries like China, Brazil, India and South Africa. Ideal-ist is part funded by the European Commission and supports research organisations and companies worldwide

- to find partners for their project ideas.
- to join projects and
- to find services leading them to success in the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework programme.

Furthermore, the main goal is the enhancement of cooperation between the national NCPs within FP7 and an overall improvement of quality across Europe in the dynamically growing area of ICT.

This is in line with the international cooperation strategy of the European Commission.

## How Did Ideal-ist Help?

---

Ideal-ist PS-ES-3297 “eGov4ALL” (at the end, presented to the CIP-ICT-PSP Programme (3 call) as “DIEGO”) received 28 EoI from 8 Member States (Spain, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, and 1 Candidate State (Turkey). Croatia contact with us using indirectly Ideal-ist, but they didn’t use Ideal-ist forms.

TOTAL: 29 EoI that we consider a “very good” score.

Five registered Ideal-ist EoI plus Croatia were accepted in the Consortium:

6 partners (as beneficiaries) coming from Ideal-ist. Other 4 potential partners coming from Ideal-ist fit too very well in the PARTNER PROFILE SOUGHT.

At the end of the proposal, the Consortium was composed by 20 partners.

The proposal DIEGO was successfully evaluated, being one of the projects invited by the EC to start the negotiation phase of the project.

During the negotiation, the EC, following too evaluators’ recommendations, imposed a reduction of Consortium: finally we are 13 partners from six different countries: Spain, Ireland, UK, Greece, Italy, and Cyprus. 3 of registered Ideal-ist EoI are part of the final Consortium.

## What Is the Project About?

The main outcome of **DIEGO**, will be to offer to any European Public Authority a **FULL e-accessibility** front-end for **e-Gov** services, **highly scalable** and **affordable**:

1) a **new “user-centric”** and **accessible** service provision model for speeding up **Inclusive e-Government & e-Governance (Inclusive e-Gov)**, including **trans-borders services**, according to **preferred ICT media available** (interactive TV, smart mobile devices, [desktop] kiosks or PCs) to their respective citizens;

2) and a **“highly scalable Deployment Model”**, based on a **Software as a Service (SaaS)** approach and widely accepted **webservices standards** (guarantee of interoperability with any back-office) and the **affordability** of the implementation, beyond the project (in the **self-sustainability** phase).

**DIEGO** main target is to provide, a friendly and easy way of transforming pre-existing e-Gov services, removing their ICT barriers (e-Exclusion), or creating new ones “from scratch” widely inclusive from the beginning, based on “open source best practice” across all Europe.
