Ideal-ist offers an access point for ICT proposers at the ICT PSP Info day on 14 January 2010.

The Ideal-ist project has been successfully performing Partner Search for two Information and Communication Technologies Policy Support Programme (ICT PSP) Calls, which is performed under the Competitiveness and Innovation Programme (CIP). Ideal-ist intends to continue offering the Partner Search service also for the ICT PSP 4th Call in 2010 and therefore organises a Workshop at NCP level on a possible collaboration between ICT National Contact Points (NCPs) of FP7 and ICT PSP NCPs on 13 January 2010 in Brussels.

Furthermore an Ideal-ist booth will be manned on 14 January 2010 and serves as access point for ICT proposers to meet ICT PSP proposers or NCPs.

Ideal-ist Partner Search Proves Effective

A recently published evaluation report by Ideal-ist demonstrates that a high interest among European and Non-European participants is shown in the electronic partner search system implemented and supported by Ideal-ist and its Quality Team. The level of responses generated by Partner Searches during the first five ICT Calls in FP7 has demonstrated a high activity: 19,300 responses generated (Expressions of Interests) by interested organisations, which gives an average of 50 responses per launched Partner Search.
